The footpath leading from Mjhipada to Binikei is not a notified forest road and is coming within the critical wildlife habitat and core area of Satakosia Tiger Reserve. Hence , it is not possible to take up any work for improvement and up gradation of the path without prior approval of National Board for Wildlife , New Delhi. Hence , necessary proposal to be submitted by the user agencies (Rural Development or other Agency) with details of wildlife Assessment reports under Forest Right Act.</p>
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
